


69% of students say the rules about alcohol, cigarettes and other drugs are clear in their family.

81% of students do not believe that the penalties/consequences for drug use at SCHOOL stop persons from using/buying/selling drugs.

85% of students do not believe that the penalties/consequences for drug use in the COMMUNITY stop persons from using/buying/selling drugs.
