Once you have determined your child is using drugs, the next step is to find a treatment that is best for your child and your family.

Instructions

- **STEP 1:** Seek out a certified drug counselor who will help your family find a treatment program.
- **STEP 2:** Enlist the aid of your family physician, the local hospital, the school social worker, the school substance abuse coordinator, other parents whose children have been treated for drug abuse.
- **STEP 3:** Call one of the key agencies listed below for referrals.
