NOTE: A total of 35 admissions (34 persons) for Detox were made to the Medical ward in the year 2001; 11 females and 23 males. (One female patient was admitted twice; all others, once).							
The number of males admitted doubled the number of females.							
Average length of stay for females and males were both 5 days; with exception of one long term for male: 11 days.							
The age group most affected were 26-35 and 36-45 and accounts for 71 % of total admissions for Detox.							
The 3 leading reason for admission were: 'multiple drug use' (14), followed by alcohol (10) and cocaine (7).
